Minutes of November 29, 2022

- I. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. Present: Fred Ehrlenbach, John Bennett, Daniel Monahan, Danielle Cole, and Carol Walsh. Charles Farley, Jr. was excused. In attendance were Mike Gilmartin, Jessica Thurston, Chyann Murphy, Chip Roskom, Brant Viner, Christina Heiniger, Rachel Nobel. Virtual attendees: Starr Gilmartin, Margaret Harling.
- II. Visitors to be Heard: None
- III. Acceptance of Agenda: Add the nomination of ANP Advisory Commission member for next term. To go under new business.
- IV. Approval of Minutes of November 15, 2022: Bennett motioned to approve; Monahan seconded. Vote: 4 Yes.
- V. Old Business:
 - a. Fire Department: It was noted that the Chief submitted a written report which was in each Select packet.

Monahan asked what the job included and Ehrlenbach said the group meets 3 x year to advise the park on some of their proposals and review their projects. The meeting is at 1pm on a week day.
